

ZJGSU INTERNATIONAL LAW PROFESSORS PARTICIPATE IN DISPUTE SETTLEMENT CONFERENCE IN BEIJING



Professor Dr Song Jie, Vice-Dean of the Law School, and Professor Dr Suzannah Linton, Distinguished Professor in the International Law Department of the Law School, were invited to participate in a Conference on the Peaceful Settlement of International Disputes and the Function of International Judicial Bodies. It was hosted by Professor Ma Chengyuan of the School of International Law at the China University of Political Science and Law on 13 and 14 March 2017.

Vice-Dean Song spoke on 'Protection of the Common Interest in International Law – A Perspective of the Judicial Decisions of the International Court of Justice' and Professor Linton examined arbitration in her presentation on 'From Battlefield to Peaceful Dispute Settlement: the Enduring Contribution of the Ethiopia-Eritrea Claims Commission'. Contributions from the eminent participants included presentations on WTO Dispute Settlement, UNCLOS litigation as well as Chinese practice in the peaceful settlement of international disputes.
