

PROFESSOR SUZANNAH LINTON SPEAKS ON 'THE KOREAN PENINSULA: INTERNATIONAL LAW PERSPECTIVES'



Over 6-7 December 2017, Professor Suzannah Linton was the guest of the Law Research Group at the Law School of the University of Huddersfield in the United Kingdom.

She gave a two hour presentation to staff and postgraduate students on International Law issues arising from the situation on the divided Korean peninsula, focusing on whether the law of peace or war applied on the peninsula, the legality of North Korea's testing of nuclear weapons and inter-continental ballistic weapons, as well as the findings of the 2014 United Nations Commission of Inquiry on the Democratic People's Republic of Korea. A lively discussion with the attendees followed.

Professor Linton then joined staff and postgraduate students for an early Christmas dinner in Huddersfield.
